13h30 / 19h00

13h30: Depart with your 2 english speaking guides from the Palais du Grand Large with 2 coaches (55 + 51 seats = for **106** people) for the Mont St Michel by the coastal road with commentaries on board. (time: 1h10) Arrival on the coach car pak (P7) situated at 400 meters from the free shuttle.

Access to Mont-Saint-Michel is then possible by using the free 'Passeur' shuttle bus, it will take 10 mn.

Then you will have 1h30 guided tour of the abbey by group of 35 people. (=3 groups)

You will discover the history and architecture of this unique World Heritage Site.

Informations:

- ✓ It is important to allow at least 40 minutes to get from the car-park area via shuttle bus, to the entrance of Mont Saint-Michel village and then 20 mn more to get to the abbey entrance.
- ✓ Please wear comfortable shoes
- ✓ Important : it is essential to respect the meeting time. As the time slot pre reserved to visit Abbey by the guide cannot be modified.

After the tour, you will come back down to get the return shuttle to the coach car park. Your return to St Malo will be between **19h & 19h30**.









Timing: 14h00 / 17h00

14h00: Meeting in front of the Palais du Grand Large with your enflish speaking guide.

You will discover the Corsaire city, **Saint-Malo** is still defended by its historic ramparts, while the islands adjoining the town continue to be fortified by 17th century bastions.

You will walk the cobbled streets inside the ramparts and discover the sumptuous residences of the people who became wealthy thanks to the corsairs in the 17th and 18th centuries, and then you will climb the ramparts to discover panoramas of the sea, the **island of Grand Bé, the National Fort, Dinard** sea resort and the magnificent granite houses of the rich shipowners of the city.

You will then board a private boat to enjoy more than an hour to discover the maritime treasures around St Malo, Dinard and the city of Aleth. The Emerald Coast will no longer hold any secrets for you! (2 boats of 12 seats)

Discover a know-how, a profession OYSTER FARMING: A LIVING HERITAGE

Joseph Pichot was in charge of the family oyster farm "Les Parcs St. Kerber" in 1968 and had the idea of upgrading the oyster heritage. So in 1989 the Marine Farm opened its doors to the public. The aim was to familiarise visitors with the specifics of the oyster farming profession.

Situated in a magnificent and preserved environment, our site offers a breathtaking view of the port of Cancale and its bay. The influence of the tides on the landscape is undeniable. At high tide, the sound of the waves will accompany your visit. At low tide, you can admire our oyster beds.

The breeding of this valuable mollusk is hard work. Many manipulations are necessary for the growth of the Cancalaise pearl.

No wonder that this oysters have been included in the list of intangible cultural heritage of France by UNESCO since November 2019.

During this tour you will be invited to discover the oyster farm of Parcs St Kerber in a splendid setting. A one-hour guided tour takes you to the heart of the company.

The history and breeding of this delicious mollusk will have no more secrets for you!

A short documentary will present the hard work of our oyster farmers in the oyster beds. You will explore the sorting and packing workshops.

The tour ends with a moment of conviviality with an oyster tasting with a glass of white wine.

16h30: Depart and return to St Malo.
